

# *Records*

Guard Russell Robinson is Reno's single-season leader in points (617), assists (219) and steals (105). Robinson was the Bighorns' second-round selection in the 2008 NBA D-League Draft after winning a national championship in the 2007-08 season at the University of Kansas.

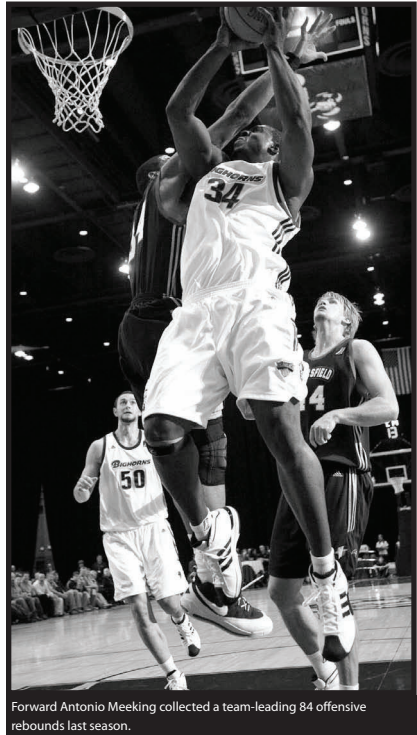

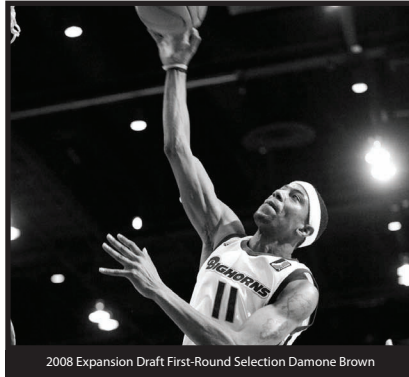
