- ♦ Appeared in team-high-tying 49 games this season (missed game on 3/26 at SXF due to ankle injury)
- ♦ One of two rookies on Bighorns roster (Fortson)

**F 42 Marcus Landry 6-7 230 lbs. Wisconsin**

- ♦ Represented Reno in 2011 D-League All-Star Game (scored 18 points in ASG)
- ♦ Scored in double figures in 45-of-49 games this season
- ♦ Led team with 48 starts (2nd: Sloan, 33)

**F 32 Bobby Simmons 6-6 235 lbs. DePaul**

- ♦ Has played 438-career NBA games with Wizards, Clippers, Bucks, Nets and Spurs
- ♦ Matched a Bighorns team-season-high with 17 rebounds on 3/18 at UTA
- ♦ Bighorns are 8-0 in games Simmons has started (9-1 overall since Simmons joined team)

**F 19 Anthony Richardson 6-8 225 lbs. Florida State**

- ♦ Acquired in a trade with New Mexico on 1/3/11 (for F Gerard Anderson)
- ♦ Reno is 22-5 with Richardson in starting lineup
- ♦ Has 6 games with 20+ points since joining Bighorns (0 in 13 games with New Mexico)

**C 44 Patrick O'Bryant 7-0 250 lbs. Bradley**

- ♦ Acquired in a trade with Bakersfield on 1/12 (for Bighorns 2011 1st Round draft pick)
- ♦ Recorded season highs in points (25), rebounds (17) and blocks (5) on 3/6 at DAK
- ♦ Former 9th overall pick in NBA Draft (Golden State, 2006)

### The Fast Break

**At a Glance:** Tonight, the Bighorns open the 2011 playoffs against Erie, after the 'Horns picked the BayHawks as their first-round opponent...Reno won the Western Conference and earned the second-overall seed in the playoffs...after Iowa chose Utah with the first selection, Reno picked Erie over Bakersfield and Texas...this marks the second-consecutive season that Reno has earned a playoff berth...last season, the Bighorns lost to Rio Grande Valley in the first round, 2 games to 1...Reno comes into tonight's contest riding a franchise-record eight-game winning streak.

**All-Time Series:** Tonight's epic battle marks the 5th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and **Matt Bresee's Erie BayHawks**...the two teams have split the first four games in the all-time series...the 'Horns won the lone meeting between the two teams this season, 100-89 (3/16 in Reno)...Reno lost its only previous game in Erie, which was played on 12/27/08 (88-83)...there are no players on Reno's current roster that appeared in that game.

**The Defense Rests:** Reno led the league in two major defensive categories this season...first, it allowed a league-best 98.1 ppg...one of three teams to hold opponents under 100 points per game...held opponents under 100 points in six-straight games and seven-of-eight...during current eight-game winning streak, have allowed just 89.4 ppg...also, Reno led the D-League in opponents FG% (44.0%)...have allowed opponent to shoot 50% or higher just two times in their last 33 games.

**Picking Up the Slack:** Bighorns **G Donald Sloan** has had a tale of two seasons...over first 17 games, served as back-up to starting point guard Aaron Miles...earned just one start over first 17 games and averaged 7.4 ppg and 1.5 app...Miles was lost for season on 1/5 (knee injury) and Sloan took over as point guard...over final 33 games, started 32 times (missed one game due to injury)...averaged 12.5 ppg and 5.9 app after taking over as starting point guard...also recorded seven double-doubles since taking over as starter (did not record double-double in first 17 games).

**Mr. Perfect:** The Bighorns are 8-0 since **F Bobby Simmons** broke into the starting lineup...Simmons was signed from the available player pool on 3/9...scored 8 points off the bench in each of his first two games before earning his first start on 3/16 vs. Erie...has averaged 17.3 ppg and 10.1 rpg in eight games as a starter...Simmons averaged 9.4 ppg and 4.0 rpg in nine NBA seasons.

**Par For the Course:** The Bighorns finished the regular season with a 34-16 record in **Head Coach Eric Musselman's** first year at the helm (.680 winning percentage)...record is right on par with Musselman's career CBA winning percentage of .688 (270-122 overall)...Musselman also posted a 53-3 career mark in the USBL (.946)...Musselman's career minor league record is now 357-141 (.717)...also holds a career 108-138 record in 3 seasons as an NBA head coach with the Sacramento Kings and Golden State Warriors (.439 winning percentage).

**Biggest Little Notes in the World:** Reno used 14 different starting lineups this season...just one lineup started more than six games together...17 players started at least one game for the 'Horns...14 different players have led the 'Horns in scoring in a game...the Bighorns have had two GATORADE Call-Ups (Danny Green, Steve Novak) and two assigned players (Hassan Whiteside, Jeremy Lin)...had no call-ups and one assignment combined in first two seasons as a franchise.

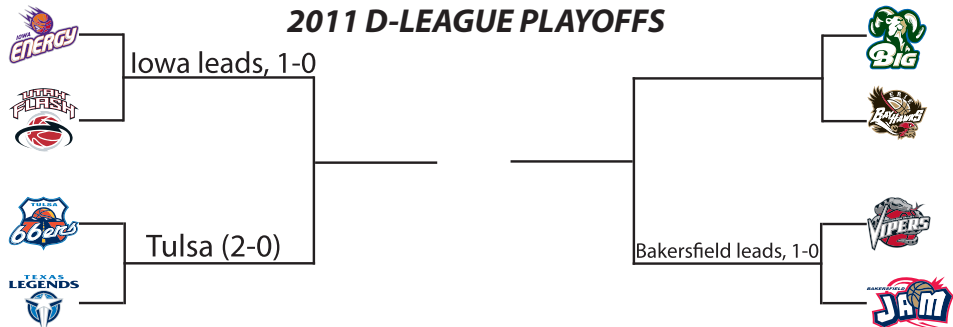

## reno bighorns gameday information

**BAKERSFIELD, Calif.**—Despite playing their third game in five nights on the heels of a seven-hour overnight bus trip, the Reno Bighorns clinched their first-ever Western Conference championship by defeating Bakersfield 94-83 on Saturday night in the Jam Events Center.

Tonight's victory—Reno's franchise-record eighth-straight win to close out the regular season—gives the 'Horns the second-overall seed and the opportunity to choose their first-round playoff opponent in the 2011 NBA Development League playoffs.

Reno (34-16) fell behind early, trailing by as many as nine points in the first quarter, but clamped down on defense the rest of the way to improve to 6-1 this season against the playoff-bound Bakersfield Jam (29-21). Tonight marked the sixth-straight game that Reno has held an opponent to fewer than 100 points, finishing the regular season with a league-best 98.1 points per game allowed average.

Marcus Landry, the only player in tonight's starting lineup that also started for the Bighorns on Opening Night, led Reno with 21 points. Five other Bighorns players chipped in with at least 10 points, helping Reno improve to 12-3 this season when at least six players register double-digit scoring efforts.

Los Angeles Clippers assignee Willie Warren led the Jam with 22 points, while Drew Naymick finished with 16 points and 11 rebounds.

Reno held Bakersfield to just 42.7 percent shooting, finishing the regular season with a D-League-best 44.0 percent opponents field goal percentage.
