The Fast Break

At a Glance: This afternoon, the Bighorns look for their 2nd-straight victory overall and 4th-straight victory in the Reno Events Center...last night, Reno snapped a 2-game losing streak with a dominant 102-87 victory over the 66ers...Reno never trailed in the game...last night's victory marked Reno's 3rd win of the season by a double-digit margin (15 points)...the Bighorns have now held their opponent to 90 points or fewer on 4 occasions.

All-Time Series: Today's titanic struggle marks the 4th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Ryan Williams' Tulsa 66ers...Reno leads the all-time series 3-0...tonight's game marks the 2nd of 3 scheduled matchups between the 2 squads this season, all in Reno...**G Russell Robinson** has averaged 14.3 points in 3-career games vs. Tulsa...**G Desmon Farmer** spent 2 seasons with Tulsa (2005-07), while **C Cezary Trybanski** played in 48 games for the 66ers in the 2006-07 season.

Rolling a 300: With less than a minute remaining in the 1st quarter last night, **G Desmon Farmer** connected on a 3-point attempt, marking 3-pointer No. 300 of his NBA D-League career...becomes just the 2nd player in league history to reach the 300 plateau in 3-point field goals...trails only Billy Thomas in D-League career 3-pointers made (347)...Farmer enters today's game ranked 2nd in the D-League with 2.6 3-pointers made per game...his 26 3-pointers this season are tied for 2nd most in the league.

Grand Theft Basketball: Through 10 games this season, **F Mo Charlo** and **C Rod Benson** have combined to become the best steals duo in the NBA D-League...the pair is averaging 4.9 steals per game this season, the highest total for a pair of teammates in the D-League...4 of Reno's 5 regular starters are ranked in the top-15 in the league in steals per game (Charlo, 2.7; Benson, 2.2; **G Desmon Farmer**, 1.7; **G Russell Robinson**, 1.7)...the Bighorns enter today's game with 108 steals on the season, 3rd-most in the league.

Success from the Stripe: **G Desmon Farmer** has made 32-straight free-throw attempts, with his last miss coming on 12/13 vs. BAK...has hit 63 of his last 68 attempts (92.6 percent)...is shooting 87.5 percent from the line on the season (70-of-80)...is ranked 3rd all-time in the D-League with 527-career free throws made...is a career 76.5 percent free-throw shooter in the D-League...as a team, Reno is ranked 2nd in the D-League in free throws made (244) and attempted (336).

Back-to-Back Bighorns: Tonight's game marks the 2nd of back-to-back games between Reno and Tulsa...Reno will play against the same opponent in consecutive games 18 times this season (including 4-straight vs. Utah, 1/20-1/31)...the Bighorns enter today's game 1-2 in the 2nd of back-to-back games against the same opponent...last season, the Bighorns went 4-1 (.800) in the 2nd game of consecutive matchups vs. the same opponent.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: Last night's victory marked No. 30 in Bighorns franchise history...with last night's win, Reno is back to the .500 mark for the 3rd time this season and 6th time in franchise history...with 10:43 remaining in last night's game, **G Eric Devendorf** hit a running layup, marking his first-career professional points scored.

RENO, Nev.— The Reno Bighorns never trailed Saturday night, halting a two-game losing streak with a 102-87 wire-to-wire victory over the Tulsa 66ers in the Reno Events Center.

The Bighorns (5-5) jumped out to an early advantage and never turned back, defeating the 66ers (6-6) in the first of two-straight games between the two squads.

Reno's Desmon Farmer led all scorers with 24 points, registering 15 of those in the first quarter. Russell Robinson scored 20 points, while Mo Charlo chipped-in a double-double with 15 points and 10 rebounds.

D.J. White, assigned to the 66ers from the Oklahoma City Thunder just prior to Saturday's game, led Tulsa with 19 points and nine rebounds. Mustafa Shakur hit 8-of-11 shots from the field for 17 points in addition to five assists.

The Bighorns outrebounded Tulsa by a 42-28 margin, and Reno nearly doubled the 66ers' points in the paint.
