The Fast Break

At a Glance: Tonight, the Bighorns look to reach the .500 mark for the first time this season on the heels of a 101-79 victory over Los Angeles last night in the Staples Center...Reno finished its season-opening 3-game road swing at 1-2 (.333)...the Bighorns have topped the 100-point plateau in all 3 contests this season...**C Rod Benson** has recorded a double-double in 2-straight games.

All-Time Series: Tonight's titanic struggle marks the 8th all-time meeting between Reno and Gina Gonsalves' Los Angeles D-Fenders...Reno leads the all-time series 5-2...the Bighorns lead the season series 1-0...the Bighorns are 3-0 all-time vs. the D-Fenders in the Reno Events Center...tonight's game marks the 2nd of 4 scheduled matchups between the 2 squads in the 2009-10 season.

Block Party: Last night in LA, **C Cezary Trybanski** came off the bench to record 9 blocks in 24 minutes of action...marked the highest single-game block total in the NBA D-League this season and tied for the 6th-most in D-League history...9 blocks marked a Bighorns single-game individual franchise record...in 53 games in franchise history, Reno has only topped 9 blocks as a team 4 times...last night, the Bighorns recorded 16 team blocks, a new franchise high (previously 13, at IOW, 3/26/09) and the most in the D-League this season...Trybanski enters tonight's game ranked 1st in the D-League with 5.5 blocks per game...he currently sits at 2nd in D-League history with 249-career blocks.

Home, Sweet Home: Tonight's game marks the 1st of the season at home for Reno...the Bighorns are 18-7 (.720) all-time in the Reno Events Center...last season, Reno finished the season on a 4-game winning streak at home...the Bighorns won 10 of their final 11 home games of the season a year ago.

Back-to-Back Bighorns: Tonight's game marks the 2nd of back-to-back games between Reno and Los Angeles...Reno will play against the same opponent in consecutive games 18 times this season (including 4-straight vs. Utah, 1/20-1/31)...the Bighorns enter tonight's game 0-1 in the 2nd of back-to-back games against the same opponent (11/30 at Idaho)...last season, the Bighorns went 4-1 (.800) in the 2nd game of consecutive matchups vs. the same opponent...on 1/13/09, the Bighorns defeated LA 119-114 at the Reno Events Center in the 2nd of consecutive meetings between the 2 teams.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: With 18 points last night at LA, **G Desmon Farmer** moved into sole possession of 4th place on the NBA D-League's career scoring list (2,299 pts.)...**F Doug Thomas** made his Bighorns debut last night, scoring 2 points and pulling down 3 rebounds in 16 minutes off the bench...Reno held LA to 0 3-point field goals last night, the lowest team total in the D-League this season...the Bighorns lead all D-League teams this season in blocks per game (10) and free-throw attempts per game (34.67).

LOS ANGELES— A quick start and a dominant second-half effort lifted the Reno Bighorns to their first victory of the young season Friday night, a 101-79 defeat of the Los Angeles D-Fenders in the Staples Center.

The Bighorns (1-2) hopped out to a 10-0 lead in the game's first two minutes, and though Reno would eventually relinquish the advantage, the Bighorns outscored Los Angeles 54-34 in the second half to roll to their first win.

Desmon Farmer led six Bighorns in double-figures with 18 points and nine assists. Farmer finished 5-for-11 from beyond the arc, and Reno as a team connected on 10 three-point field goals.

Rod Benson recorded his second-straight double with 17 points and 10 boards, while Russell Robinson dished out 10 assists. Cezary Trybanski came off the bench to score 10 points and block nine shots.

Diamon Simpson led the D-Fenders (2-2) with 24 points and 13 rebounds. James Jackson scored 22 off the bench for Los Angeles.
