## The Fast Break

**At a Glance:** Today, the Bighorns look to win their 5th-straight game, which would be a new season-high...the Bighorns are now 3 games over .500, the high-water mark in franchise history...Reno trails Tulsa by just 0.5 games for the 8th and final playoff spot with just 3 games remaining (4 remaining for Tulsa)...it would be Reno's first playoff berth in franchise history...Reno is coming off back-to-back 2-game sweeps of Los Angeles (at LA) and Maine (at home)...tonight is Reno's 5th game in the last 7 days...tonight is the 3rd game of a season-long, season-ending 5-game homestand.

**All-Time Series:** Tonight's titanic struggle marks the 7th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Ryan Williams' Tulsa 66ers...Reno leads the all-time series 4-2, with all 6 previous games between the 2 clubs having been played in Reno...Reno and Tulsa have split the first 4 games of the 09-10 season...Reno took both games against the 66ers last season...**G Desmon Farmer** is averaging 25.3 ppg in 4 games against Tulsa this season, while **C Rod Benson** is averaging 16.5 ppg and 10.3 rpg.

**What Ifs:** With just 3 games remaining for Reno (4 for Tulsa), the 2 teams are in a virtual dead heat for the league's 8th and final playoff spot...heading into tonight's game, Reno (25-22) trails Tulsa (25-21) by just a half-game...a win tonight would give Reno temporary control of the 8th spot, as well as securing the tie-breaker (by virtue of a 3-2 season-series lead) against Tulsa if the 2 teams were to finish the season with identical records...if Tulsa wins, it would win the season-series against Reno and be granted the 8th spot if the 2 teams finish the season tied...Utah currently sits at 26-21, one game ahead of Reno and a half-game ahead of Tulsa...if Reno and Utah finish tied for the 8th spot, Reno would hold the tie-breaker (6-4 victory in season series)...if Reno wins tonight—and all 3 teams finish tied—Reno and Tulsa would get the 7th and 8th spots, respectively...if Tulsa wins tonight—and all 3 teams finish tied—Reno and Tulsa would still both get in, with Tulsa finishing 7th and Reno finishing 8th.

**The Century Mark:** Saturday's 96-85 win over Maine marked the 1st time in 12 games that Reno did not reach 100 points in a game...Reno is 9-3 since the last time it scored fewer than 100 points (2/27 vs TUL; L, 96-94)...on the season, the Bighorns are 21-14 when scoring 100+ points...they are just 4-8 when failing to reach the century mark...when holding opponents to fewer than 100 points, Reno is 14-4, including a 4-0 mark when it allows fewer than 90 points in a game.

**Deadly Frahm Distance:** **G Richie Frahm** currently leads the league in 3-point field goal percentage at 48.4%...he has made 45-of-93 three-pointers in 13 games with the 'Horns...has knocked down 3+ threes in 9-of-13 games...shot 13-15 (86.7%) from distance over a 2-game stretch earlier this season (2/28, 3/5)...Reno is 9-4 overall since Frahm joined the team on 2/27.

**Biggest Little Notes in the World:** Reno is 0-3 this season when playing on Mondays...Bighorns improved their record to 20-5 Saturday night when dishing out more assists than their opponent...Reno is 16-7 all-time in the month of March, including an 8-3 mark this season (8-4 last season)...it is 5-1 all-time in April.

**RENO, Nev.**—With their backs against the wall and hopes of a playoff berth threatened, the Reno Bighorns used a dominant fourth-quarter effort to collect a key 96-85 come-from-behind victory over the Maine Red Claws Saturday night in front of a raucous crowd in the Reno Events Center.

The victory marked Reno's fourth straight, and put the Bighorns (25-22) in a virtual tie with the Tulsa 66ers for the eighth and final NBA D-League playoff spot. Tulsa plays Sunday, then the Bighorns and 66ers will meet on Monday in the Reno Events Center with significant playoff implications on the line.

Maine (27-21) took a four-point lead into the break, and the Red Claws would grow the advantage to as many as 10 in the third quarter. But the Bighorns steadily carved into the Maine advantage, eventually taking the lead with 10:18 remaining in the ballgame.

The Red Claws would regain the lead, 73-70, with just less than nine minutes to play, but the Bighorns would go on a 13-0 run to take a lead they would not relinquish, sealing the weekend sweep.

Desmon Farmer led all scorers with 22 points for Reno. Richie Frahm and D.J. Strawberry each collected 12 points off the bench. Doug Thomas finished with 11 points and nine rebounds.

Paul Davis and Maurice Ager shared the scoring lead for Maine with 17 points apiece. Kurt Looby kicked-in 10 points and 12 boards for the game's lone double-double.
