The Fast Break

At a Glance: Tonight, the Bighorns look to win their 4th-straight game, which would match their longest winning streak of the season (1/12-20)...the 'Horns currently sit 1.5 games behind Utah for the league's 8th and final playoff spot, with 12 games remaining...as of this evening, both Reno and Idaho are chasing Utah for the 8th spot...after tonight's game, Reno plays 9 of its final 11 games at home, including a pivotal 2-game weekend series on 3/12-13 against the Flash.

All-Time Series: Tonight's titanic struggle marks the 9th all-time meeting between the Bighorns and Matt Kolsky's Bakersfield Jam...Reno leads the all-time series 5-3, and enters tonight's game having won 3-straight games against the Jam...the Bighorns have won both games against Bakersfield this season (12/13, 12/15 in Reno)...in the 2 games this season, Reno has held Bakersfield to just 89.0 ppg, as it defeated the Jam by a combined 29 points over the 2 games in December.

It's Raining Threes: Since a season-low 2-for-18 (11.1%) performance from 3-point range on 2/27 vs TUL, Reno has lit it up from beyond the arc...the Bighorns have shot 31-for-60 (51.7%) from 3-point range over their last 3 games (all wins)...28.3% of Reno's points have come via the 3-pointer in these 3 games, compared with just 17.5% over its 1st 35 games...a Bighorn player has made 5+ 3-pointers in each of the last 3 games (Frahm—twice; Farmer—once).

D-Fense...D-Fense...D-Fense: Sunday evening at home against Springfield, Reno allowed a season-low 77 points...it was the 2nd time this season the Bighorns had allowed fewer than 80 points in a game (also 12/4 at LA)...Reno is 2-0 when allowing fewer than 80 points, and 11-4 when its opponent scores fewer than 100 points in a game...Reno also set a season-high on Sunday with 16 steals.

Let'em Play, Ref: Sunday's game was the shortest in terms of time that Reno has played this season, clocking in at just 1:53...the 2 teams combined to shoot just 32 free throws, which also set a season-low for a game involving the 'Horns...just 33 personal fouls were called during the game, which ties Reno's season-low for the fewest combined fouls in a game this season (also 2/10 vs IDA).

No Love From the Big Boys: Reno and Bakersfield are just 2-of-4 teams in the D-League that have had neither an NBA assignee nor a Gatorade Call-Up this season (also Albuquerque, Los Angeles)...Dakota has not had a Gatorade Call-Up (but has had an assignee), while Springfield has not been assigned a player (but has had a Gatorade Call-Up)...the other 10 teams in the league have had at least one assignee and Gatorade Call-Up.

Biggest Little Notes in the World: Reno is 2-0 in March and 7-2 since the All-Star break...last season, the Bighorns finished 14-7 after the break, including a 13-5 mark during the months of March and April...the Bighorns roster currently consists of 6 players with NBA experience (Blalock, Farmer, Frahm, Korolev, Strawberry, Trybanski)...Reno's remaining 3 road games are all in the state of California (2 at LA, 1 at BAK).

RENO, Nev.—With a playoff berth still in the crosshairs, Reno turned-in a dominant defensive effort Sunday night to roll to a 106-77 victory over the Springfield Armor in the Reno Events Center.

After leading by five points at the break, the Bighorns (19-19) limited Springfield (6-31) to just 28 second-half points to cruise to the win. Reno held a 43-38 advantage on the boards, and converted 24 Armor turnovers into 23 points.

Desmon Farmer led all scorers with 24 points for the Bighorns, helped by five three-pointers. Rod Benson finished with 17 points and nine boards, while Doug Thomas turned in a double-double with 11 points and 12 boards.

Marcus Campbell paced four Springfield starters in double figures with 10 points. Campbell and Dante Milligan each collected a team-high eight rebounds.
